The university of Salamanca (USAL) is the oldest university of Spain and the fourth oldest European university in operation. It was founded in 1134 and credited as such by Royal charter at the time of King Alfonso the Ninth in 1218. - Engaging learning environments Sustainability of learning and teaching practices.
- Innovative practices and ICT (i.e., virtual platforms, mobile & augmented learning, flipped learning, etc.)

The successful regional ISATT conference held in Braga in October 2014 has convinced us that the extensive communities of Spanish and Portuguese speaking scholars in Europe, South America, and Africa can and should be opened as new forums for ISATT.

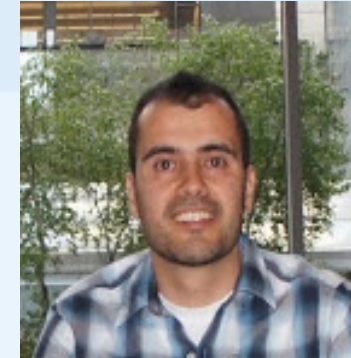

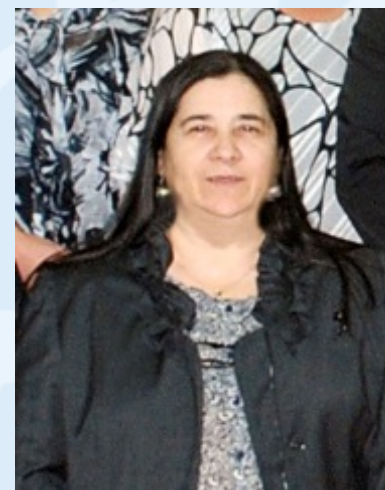

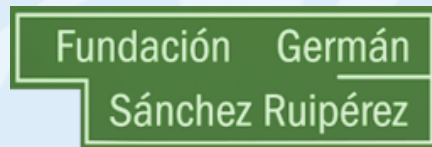

The Conference and Exhibition Centre of Castile and Leon is situated in the old town of the city of Salamanca and it is an international reference in the organization and reception of all kind of events.

Its innovative and versatile infrastructure positions the building as an excellent choice for the celebration of any event: from seminars or work meetings with few participants up to big conferences, commercial presentations, exhibitions or cultural events.

It is a modern building with multiple uses and a capacity to accommodate more than 2,500 people, equipped with the latest technology and endowed with all the necessary. It consists of three big spaces: a conference enclosure in the strictest sense, the exhibition room and the outdoor stands. Each of them offers multiple possibilities.

Its privileged location turns it into the center of the cultural, economic, commercial and social life of the city, motives for which hundreds of clients have already chosen it as their meeting point.





Main Room: We are in front of a large room with a spectacular dome on top of the main auditorium with a seating capacity of 1,065 people.

On stage, anything is possible: a brilliant lecture, a pertinent conference, a political meeting, an orchestral symphony or a theatrical performance. The extraordinary acoustics combined with the available technical resources allow this room to house any type of event.



Minor Room: It has a maximum capacity of 400 people. Like the Main Room, it has a multimedia system connects the two rooms with other external sources. Any other technical service that might be needed can be installed easily as it contains spaces prepared for their possible placement.



Multi-uses Hall: With an area of 200 m² and a characteristic design, it has a capacity of 110 people. But if the whole room is used, the capacity can be increased to 350 people.

Venue: Hospedería Fonseca

The University Residence of Fonseca (*Hospedería Fonseca*) is a 16th century palace that was used as a University student accommodation for Irish novices who came to Salamanca to study Theology at that time. For that reason the place is also known as the *Irish College*.

Nowadays it is a modern multipurpose building which serves for two purposes: on one hand it is the official USAL residence for visiting scholars. On the other hand it contains some administrative units of the USAL, such as the Extraordinary Courses Service, the Office of Cultural Activities, the Ibero-American Institute, and the General Foundation.

It is equipped with 18 institutional spaces for conferences and meetings. Two auditoriums, ten rooms, one exhibition room and five multipurpose spaces comprise an offer to cover any professional need of an event.

It also has a cafeteria and a restaurant. The accommodation in the building is suitable for people with mobility impairments.

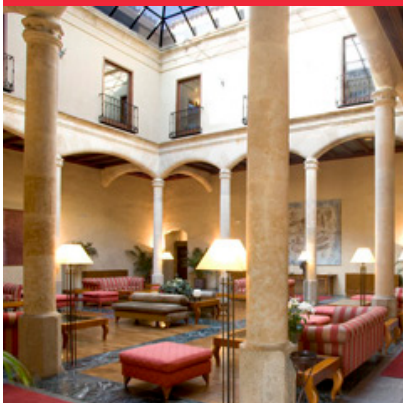
